So I bought a new clutch... What else should I consider replacing?

Congratulations on your new EXEDY clutch set! You picked the finest clutch on the market for your vehicle!

When replacing the clutch you should take a good inspection of all the clutch system components as parts may need to be addressed along with the clutch. Besides the obvious flywheel machining or replacement, you will want to inspect all components that are in the clutch system. These include: hydraulic fluid lines or cables, clutch slave cylinder, clutch master cylinder, pivot ball, and clutch fork.

You will want to ask yourself or your mechanic why does the clutch need replaced? Are you just replacing the 100,000 + mile worn out OE clutch or did the part prematurely fail causing a sudden replacement. Properly diagnosing any clutch issue will avoid wasted money and aggravation when the same issues arises right after the clutch is replaced.

For higher mileage vehicle (past 50K miles) it is recommended to replace the clutch master cylinder. Many people overlook flushing the clutch hydraulic fluid at regular intervals. The hydraulic fluid used in clutch systems is hydroscopic, meaning the fluid absorbs moisture. If your clutch hydraulic system fluid is dark to black in color it could indicate that there is possible seal deterioration in either the master or slave cylinder. Just like brake caliper pistons the clutch slave cylinder piston can become seized.

Another set of parts to consider replacing are the clutch fork and pivot ball, if equipped. Over time the stress from thousands upon thousands of clutch pedal depressions can fatigue the clutch fork and wear the pivot ball. A bent clutch fork or worn pivot ball can cause a chirping noise, vibrations in the clutch pedal, premature release bearing failure, non disengament of clutch, or creaking noise when the clutch pedal is depressed. The clutch fork and pivot ball generally are fairly cheap parts that can be purchased from the vehicle manufacture parts counter.

Correct assessment of clutch issues/failures along with following the factory service manual install procedure during clutch replacement will ensure that you have a long happy life and the best possible performance from your new EXEDY clutch set.
